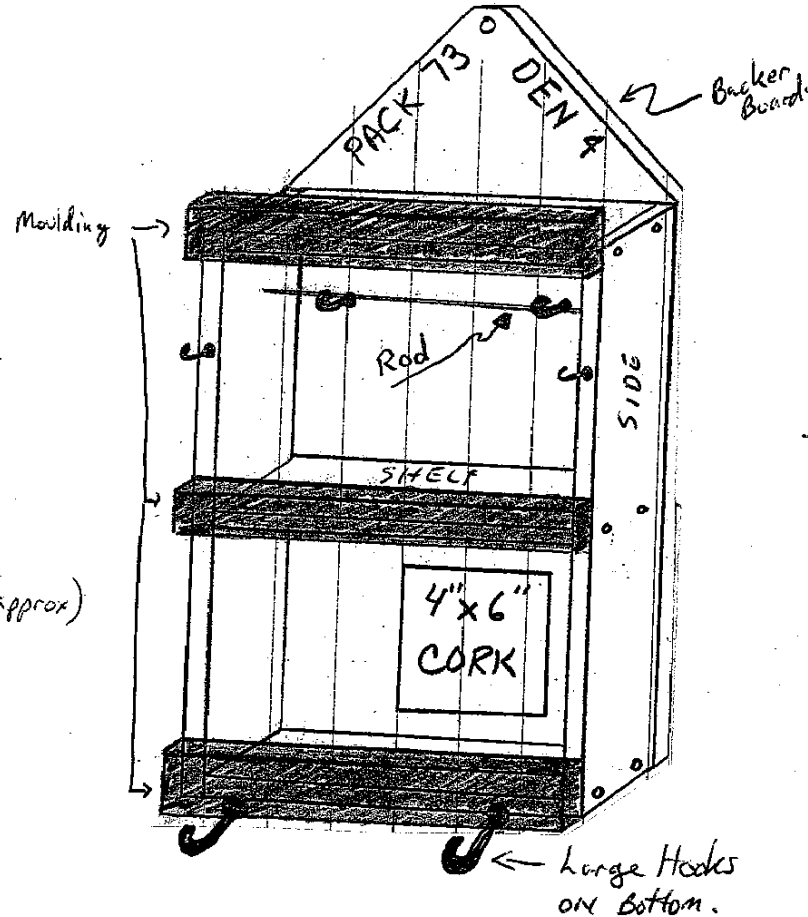

| 1  | Back Board                                  |
| 2  | 18" Sides                                   |
| 3  | Shelves 11" x 2"                            |
| 3  | Moulding 12" x 1 1/2" (approx)              |
| 4  | 5/8" Brass Hooks                            |
| 2  | 1" Brass Hooks                              |
| 1  | 4" x 6" Pe. Cork.                           |
| 1  | Coat Hanger Rod (Provided by Scout) 10 3/4" |
| 26 | Nails 1 1/4" Finish                         |
| 4  | Tack/Brads for Cork.                        |
- (All wood pre-drilled)

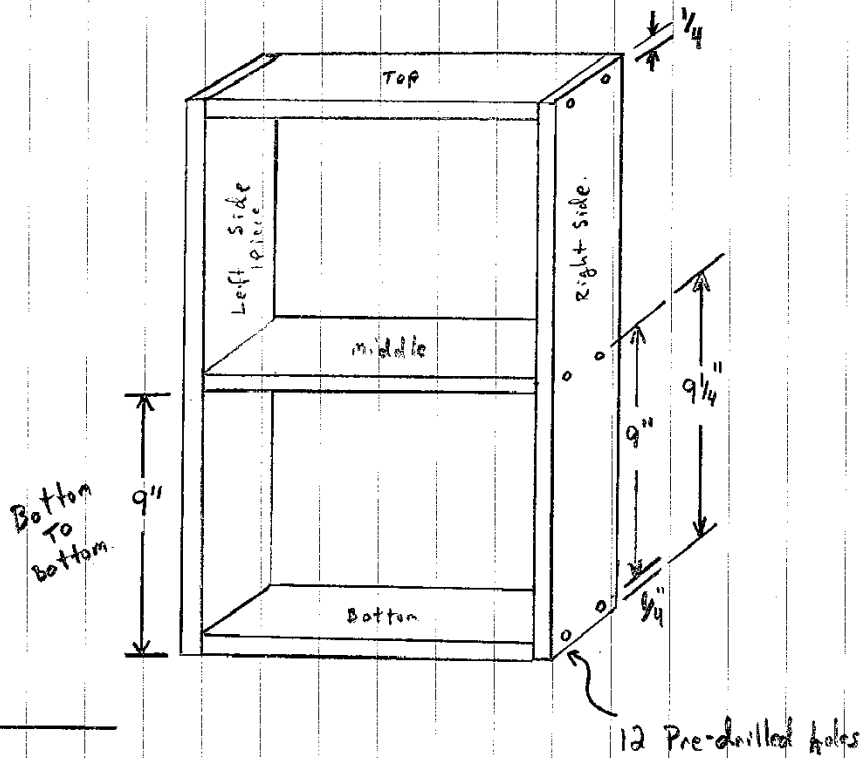

# MAKE BOX



#1

Side

2 Pcs (Left, Right)

Shelves

3 Pcs (Top, Middle, Bottom)

Hardware

12 Nails

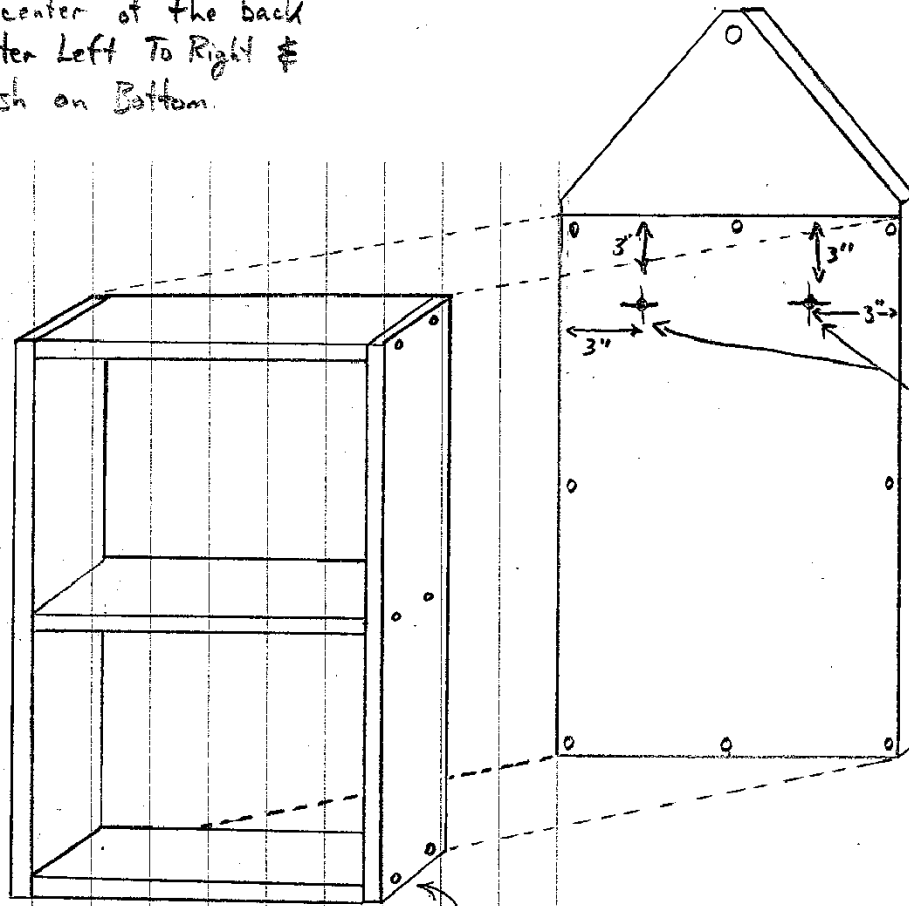
## Instructions

1. Connect 2 Sides to Top shelf
2. Connect Bottom shelf
3. Connect Middle shelf (Use Jig/Spacer)  
Bottom middle shelf should be 9" from Bottom of side.

# ATTACH BOX TO BACK

Try to mount box  
on center of the back  
Center Left To Right &  
Flush on Bottom.



8 Pre drilled Holes  
IN Back Panel

Step 1.

Mark Hook location  
First (Approx. 3" down  
3" in)

Step 2

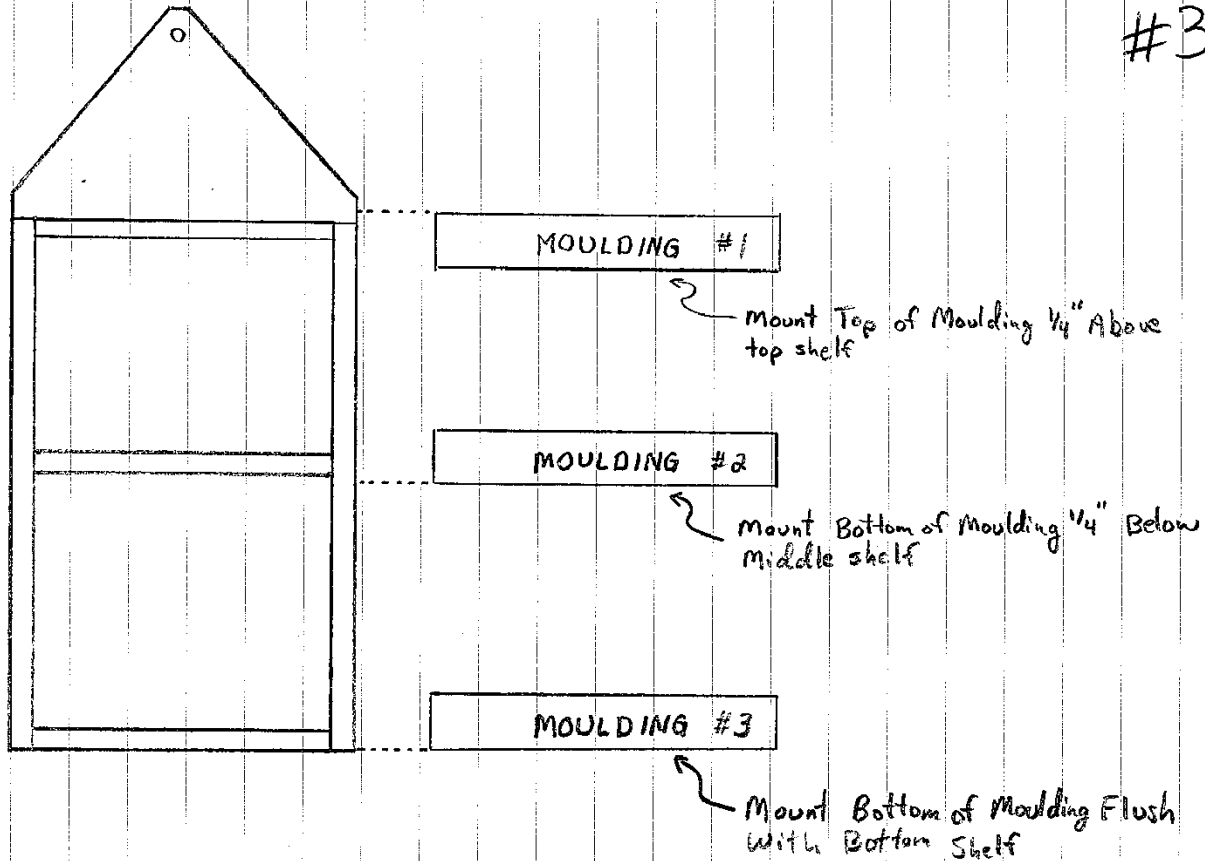
Mount Box to

Mount Bottom Box  
Flush with Bottom Back

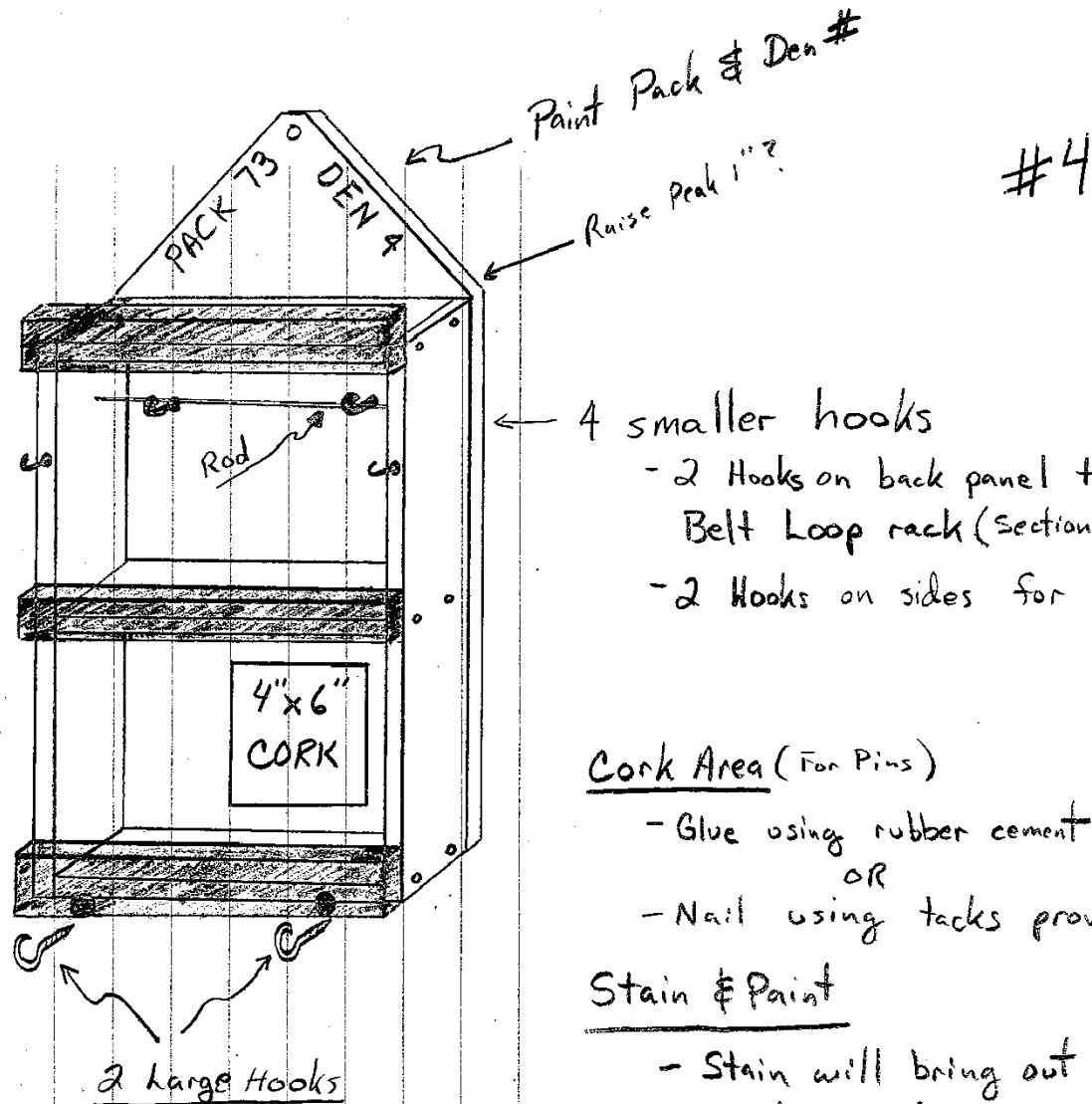
# MOULDING ATTACHMENT

- To Cover Joints
- Provides Lip for shelving

- #4
- 4 smaller hooks
    - 2 Hooks on back panel to hold Belt Loop rack (Section of white coat hanger)
    - 2 Hooks on sides for keys/compass...etc

Cork Area (For Pins)

- Glue using rubber cement
- OR
- Nail using tacks provided

Stain & Paint

- Stain will bring out the Birch wood grain. Suggest a light stain
- Paint ok. Use Primer.

- 2 Large Hooks
- Hats
